<b>4-H High Point Grand &amp; Reserve</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Six points will be given for a full class. This means a class with 6 or more entries – points will be awarded. 1st – 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd- 4 points; 4th – 3 points; 5th – 2 points; 6th – 1 point. If a class has 5 or less entries then points will be based on the number of entries. EX: If showmanship at halter has only 4 entries then 1st place would receive 4 points, 2nd – 3 points, 3rd – 2 points, 4th – 1 point.</li> </ul>

If a class has 8 or less entries then points will be based on the number of entries. EX: If showmanship at halter has only 4 entries then 1st place would receive 4 points, 2nd – 3 points, 3rd – 2 points, 4th – 1 point.</li> </ul>
